

Williams Mercury for the Virtual Schneider Project

The file Mercury.exe in this Zip archive will install the Williams Mercury into your Flight Simulator folders automatically. Simply unzip the file into a temporary folder and double-click to run the program. During the installation setup process you will be prompted for the location of the Flight Simulator 9 folder on your system, by default it is set for the standard Microsoft installation route but this can be changed. A new folder will be created for the aircraft installation named TGA_Mercury. Project documentation is in this folder.

Please read the documentation files that are included in the installation, these give additional information regarding the VSP project and also the files you have just installed.

This installation does not include any sound files but we recommend that the sounds for any of our other Schneider racers should be used.

When you run Flight Simulator the VSP aircraft can be found listed together under 'Schneider 1929' in the Flight Simulator aircraft selection window.

The aircraft are configured to use additional third-party freeware add-on effect files that are not included as part of this installation. These can be downloaded via the link on the Schneider download page on our website at www.transglobalaircraft.co.uk
